

RISK MANAGEMENT DIVISION INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR ENCROACHMENT PERMITS

Proof of insurance must be provided on an <u>ORIGINAL</u> CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE. This document must be signed, a stamped signature will suffice.

Type of Insurance Required:	General Liability
Limits of Coverage:	Bodily Injury: \$1,000,000 per occurrence \$2,000,000 aggregate Property Damage: \$1,000,000 per occurrence Personal Injury: \$1,000,000 per occurrence
Certificate Holder:	The Certificate Holder is "The City of Roseville, Attn: Risk Management, 311 Vernon St., Roseville, CA 95678".
Additional Insured :	The "City of Roseville, its officers, agents, volunteers and employees" must be specifically named as an additional insured on the policy. <u>A separate endorsement document must accompany</u> <u>the Certificate of Insurance. A statement on the</u> <u>Certificate will not suffice.</u>
Description of Operations:	This section should read "Encroachment Permit. If the Certificate is being issued to cover more than one permit the description can be generalized to reflect this.
Cancellation Notice:	The City requires a 30-day cancellation notice.
