Conversations help a child express thoughts, learn what words mean, and gain new information about the world. The more children know about the world, the more words they will recognize later on.

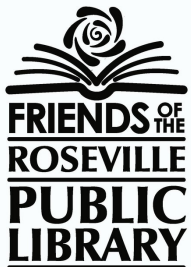
