Starting September 1, 2023, Roseville Public Library locations will have an example of the device and recorded material to answer questions of those who may benefit.

Jumbo Switch

Jumbo switch (needs the switch interface pro or interactive mouse to connect to the computer)

This capability switch will activate toys and devices with the slightest pressure from any part of the body. This switch is designed to help individuals with special needs to

increase access to computers and software.

Switch Interface Pro 6.0

This will connect up to 5 switches to a computer. The push button on the back of the unit controls how the switch will function when connected to a device.



Interactive Mouse

Patrons are able to connect the mouse to the computer and use the additional cord to attach the jumbo switch. This allows one person to control mouse movement while another person uses the switch to make left click selections.



SAM Trackball

Allows an individual with gross-motor hand (or fine motor-head) control to move the mouse with the trackball, click, double click and click-lock (for dragging).

All assistive technology must be checked out to a library patron. They are in-library use only and must be returned by the end of the day.
