Dumpsters at clean-up event locations are exclusively for household items and light yard clean-up. They are not intended for use by landscape companies for dumping purposes. Any items not accepted at the clean-up events can be taken to the Western Placer Waste Management Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) at 3195 Athens Ave in Lincoln. Please note that applicable fees will be charged.



UNACCEPTED ITEMS

- Rocks, dirt, sod, asphalt, concrete, sand, and bricks
- ANY heavy construction debris
- Household Hazardous Waste:
 - Paint
 - Flammable liquids
 - Hazardous chemicals
 - Pesticides
 - Medications
 - Compressed gas cylinders
 - Fluorescent light tubes and bulbs
 - Automotive fluids, motor oil, etc.
- Appliances
 - Washers, dryers
 - Water heaters
 - Refrigerated appliances
- FOG – Fats, oils, and greases
- Mercury-containing devices
- Electrical ballast
- Sharps
 - Syringes
 - Lancets
 - Tires
- Items with motors (lawnmowers, weed eaters, etc.)



ACCEPTABLE ELECTRONIC WASTE ITEMS

- Microwaves
- Televisions
- Computers
- Computer Monitors
- Printers
- Scanners
- VCRs
- DVD Players
- Stereos
- Tablets
- Cellphones
- Small electronic devices

Remove batteries from devices; otherwise, they will not be accepted.
